

## Entry & Rules

60<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Chili Cook-Off

1. Email John Tolentino (lki808honolulu@gmail.com) with your desire to enter and the name of your chili. All entries are tasted blind, so make sure your chili name does not reveal your identity.
2. Prepare a minimum of one (1) gallon of chili.
3. All chili types are welcome – this is an informal competition, so vegetarian chilis will be judged in the same category as carnivore chilis, green chilis, chilis with beans, bean-less chilis, mild chilis, and spicy chilis.
4. Beginning at 3:00 PM on Saturday, June 29<sup>th</sup>, bring your chili in an electric crock pot, or other pot designed to keep the chili hot. The site discourages use of their stoves for warming.
5. Contestants (being a person(s) who, pursuant to the rules of the event, bring a chili for entry into the competition) will be entitled to 1 free admission per chili entry.
6. Any condiments (i.e. sour cream, onions, chives, cheese, tortillas, etc.) must be prepared, plated, and presented alongside your entry. Contestants are required to bring their own serving utensils and condiment bowls/platters.
7. IMPORTANT: To be considered for judging and awards, chilis must be on-site no later than 4:00 PM.
8. Contestants are not allowed in the judging area while the chilis are being judged.
9. Judging will occur between 4:00 and 5:00 PM.
10. Dinner will commence at shortly after 5:00 PM.
11. Lima Kokua will provide bowls and utensils for both the judges and the guests. Serving utensils are the responsibility of the contestants.
12. Judges' awards will be presented after dinner by the organizers.
13. Wine, soda, water, and light pupus will be provided by Lima Kokua. The church has graciously offered to allow participants to bring their own beer. However, please remember that we are guests in other people's sacred space, so please drink and behave responsibly.
